To allow all families to visit safely, visits are limited to thirty minutes. Step 3: Print or Save Your Child's Schedule

Log-in to your parent portal on August 18th to download or print your child's middle school class schedule. Bring it with you when you attend our event on Wednesday, August 19th. Schedules will not be available on campus this day. You can use your schedule to explore our campus on a self-guided tour. A map will be provided upon arrival to campus.
